- Applicant must submit the completed application form.
- Applicants must include a minimum of two letters of recommendation from an individual who can attest to applicant's involvement. (may be from their own board or another chapter)
- The “unofficial” transcript of grades must be attached to the application.

## **ULSA Academic Excellence Scholarship**

The United Latino Students Association recognizes the importance of its members being actively engaged not only in an organization, but in the classroom as well. The Association wishes to promote the importance of academic excellence. Therefore, the Association has established the Academic Excellence Scholarship for the person who best personifies an ongoing commitment to “academic excellence”.

### **Application Requirements**

- Must be a paid member of their respective chapter
- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5
- Applicant must submit the completed application form.
- Applicants must include a minimum of two letters of recommendation from a professor.
- The “unofficial” transcript of grades must be attached to the application.

## **ULSA Community Service Scholarship**

The United Latino Students Association recognizes the importance of its members being actively engaged in community service. The Association wishes to promote the importance of giving back to the community. Therefore, the Association has established the Community Service Scholarship for the person who best personifies an ongoing commitment to “exemplary community service”.

### **Application Requirements**

- Must be a paid member of their respective chapter
- Applicants must have completed a minimum of 24 hours of independent community service hours within the past twelve months.
- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- Applicant must submit the completed application form.
- Applicants must include a minimum of two letters of recommendation from individuals who directly supervised their service at the service location.
- The “unofficial” transcript of grades must be attached to the application.
- The applicant must document obtained service hours received in the past twelve months on a separate sheet and include the community service completed, the name of the agency where the community service was provided, as well as the dates of service and total hours earned.

## **ULSA General Scholarship**

The United Latino Students Association General Scholarship was created to assist students with the high costs of textbooks and study materials. United Latino Students Association will award this scholarship to the candidate who demonstrate their educational goals and academic progress.

### **Application Requirements**

1. Minimum 2.5 G.P.A.
2. Current enrollment in a degree program as a fulltime student (a minimum of 12 units)
3. Graduating seniors are eligible for this scholarship.
4. Must be an official member of non-probation, eligible ULSA organization.
5. Executive Board Members and Officers are eligible.

## **ULSA Professor Biegel's Scholarship**

The United Latino Applicants Association recognizes the importance of its members being actively engaged within their own chapters organization, but also amongst the ULSA. The Association wishes to promote the importance of involvement. Therefore, the Association has established the ULSA Professor Biegel's Scholarship for the person who best personifies an ongoing commitment to ULSA involvement and they have made a difference to ULSA success this year.

### **Application Requirements**

- Must be a paid member of their respective chapter
- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- Applicant must submit the completed application form.
- Applicants must include a minimum of two letters of recommendation from an individual who can attest to applicant's involvement. (may be from their own board or another chapter)
- The "unofficial" transcript of grades must be attached to the application.

## **ULSA President Gloria Vargas Martinez's Scholarship**

The United Latino Applicants Association recognizes the importance of its members being actively engaged within their own chapters organization, but also amongst ULSA. The Association wishes to promote the importance of involvement. Therefore, the Association has established the ULSA President Gloria Vargas Martinez's Scholarship for the person who best personifies an ongoing commitment to "ULSA involvement".

- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5

- The "unofficial" transcript of grades must be attached to the application.
